The **Global Undergraduate Exchange Program (Global UGRAD)** provides a diverse group of emerging leaders from over 60 countries with a U.S.-funded scholarship for one semester of non-degree, full-time academic study at the undergraduate level at a U.S. college or university, combined with community service, professional development workshops, and cultural enrichment activities.

Participants can expect an in-depth exposure to U.S. society, culture, and academic institutions as well as an opportunity to enhance their professional skills. Global UGRAD also offers students the opportunity to share their cultures and traditions with U.S. colleagues and helps promote mutual understanding between United States and Bosnia and Herzegovina.
